Class Syllabus

Woodworking Project:

• Students shall develop the plans and required forms for at least one advanced level woodworking project, and construct the project according to the designs they have drawn. The student shall assign a difficulty level to the project and receive approval from the instructor before beginning.

Grading Standards:

- Google Account: Homework agendas will be loaded weekly on google classroom. In order for the student to get weekly homework, the student shall set up a google account using the class code: admeift
- Woodworking Project: Graded as follows:
 - Project Preparation (25%): Drafting plans, materials list, cutting list and schedule, etc.
 - Project Construction (25%): Craftsmanship and quality of project
 - Finishing (25%): Gluing, staining, and finish.
 - Work Ethic (25%): Cooperation, diligence, behavior, project difficulty level, and oral presentation
- Tests: Four exams administered throughout the semester involving both multiple choice and group testing.
- Homework: Weekly writing prompts on unit of study are found in the online textbook in google classroom.
 - Homework not turned in before the unit test shall receive a "0".
 - At least one quote from an online <u>article</u> must be included in your work (no dictionary or encyclopedia references will be accepted). Make certain the citation is in "quotation marks." Use MLA guidelines for citing work.
 - At least one quote from the class textbook (online through Valley Oaks Website), must be included in your work.
 - Homework shall be graded as follows: Internet citation(s) = 1pt. Class textbook citation(s) = 1 pt. Required amount of words = 1 pt. Followed submittal requirements = 1 pt. Turning something in = 1 pt. Resource must be listed at the bottom of the page.
 - Prompt submission requirements are found in the textbook:
- Class Involvement: Student work ethic shall be evaluated daily according to their cooperation, diligence, and behavior
- Progress Checks: Student progress in all of the above shall be evaluated every five weeks.
- Oral Presentation Final: Student presentations shall be graded according to portfolio quality and content as well as project presentation.
- **Absences**: Absent students must complete an Absentee Assignment, which is available at the front desk in the High School Office. Failure to do so will result in a daily work ethic score of "0" for the day missed.
